

# Setting up your internet

If your landlord provides internet service there should already be a modem at the apartment. First you need to locate your modem. Your modem will look like one of these. If the modem is not already set up, follow the steps below.

## COAX LINE



- The Ethernet cord comes in a variety of colors. Connect one end of the ethernet cable to the modem and the other end to what ever you would like to access the internet on. (Laptop, TV, Computer..etc.)
- The coax line will be coming through the floor or wall, or be a wall outlet. Screw the loose end to the modem, or use a coax able to connect the modem to the wall outlet.
- Connect Power cord to the modem and wall outlet.



Your modem should look similar to this once connected.

**If you want wifi, you need to purchase and connect your own router.**

**The ethernet cable goes into the WAN or INTERNET port and not one of the numbered ones on a router.**

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If your landlord provides internet be sure to leave the modem with the power cord and ethernet cord at the apartment when you move out. If your internet is not provided by your landlord be sure to return the equipment to Murray Electric System.

## Is your internet fast enough?

Murray Electric offers 5 Tiers of internet speeds. Depending on what speed you landlord offers you may want to increase your speeds.

If you are using a router, the bandwidth supplied by your modem is being shared between the number of devices connected to the network. Ex. A customer with 15 mbps that has 2 cell phones and a tv, all streaming videos, will not be getting 15Mbps at each device at the same time.
